8. Equitable Mortgage of immovable properties ranking Parri Passu with term loans from banks and Financial Institutions.
9. First charge on movable Fixed Assets ranking Parri Pasu with other loans and hypothecation of inventories and book debts against first charge and pledging of investments worth Rs. 227 lakhs ranking parri passu with demand loans from banks.
10. First charge on movable Fixed Assets ranking Parri Passu with term loans of banks second charge on inventories and debts, exclusive charge on individual assets and first charge on dwelling unit and office space apart from encumbrances referred to above.
11. Shares held at NICCO Ventures Ltd (9,19,550) fully paid equity shares of Rs. 10 each, NICCO Parks and Resorts Ltd, 1,17,00,000 Fully paid equity shares of Rs. 1 each, and NICCO Engineering services Ltd (18,33,392 Fully paid equity shares of Rs. 1 each are pledged with banks).
